NATIONAL WEBINAR ON "THINKING ABOUT THINKING: DEVELOPING CRITICAL THINKING SKILLS THROUGH PHILOSOPHY"

A One day National Webinar on "Thinking about Thinking: Developing Critical Thinking Skills through Philosophy" was organized by the Department of Philosophy, Ideal Girls' College, Akampat, Imphal East, Manipur, sponsored by the Indian Council of Philosophical Research, Delhi on 10th December, 2021. The registration link of Google Form was https://forms.gle/k3EoGDWFm3xwrtmG7. 211 participants registered for the webinar. - 2. Dr. Laimayum Blshwanath Sharma, Head of Department, Manipur University, spoke on the epistemology of critical thoughts.

- **3.** Retd. Professor Soyam Lokendrajit Singh, Department of Philosophy, Manipur University delivered his lecture on the history of critical thought.
- **4.** Mr. Anish Chakravarty, Assistant Professor, Department of Philosophy, Kamala Nehru College, University of Delhi delivered a lecture on "Ambiguity, Vagueness and the Illogical Tumbling of Jack and Jill".
- **5.** The sessions were followed by interactive sessions.

Outcomes of the Activity:

- **2.** The participants became more aware of the importance and relevance of Critical Thinking.
